

\*\*Please Note: This season has been full of uncertainties, but JCDA is committed to providing a wonderful recital experience for everyone involved. We thank you for your patience and understanding. Please know as long as we are still legally and safely able to do so, we will see you and your dancers on our big stage shortly!

#### **UPDATES**

As we get closer to the show, additional recital information can be found on the Tot Recital Website or updates will be emailed home.

Parents and students need to know the following information: Your class style & level, class day and time, the name of the teacher & the name of the dance (i.e. "Tot Jazz, Wednesday at 5:00pm, Miss Jackie, 'Sharp-Dressed Man").

We know that this time in our world has been so difficult to maneuver; so many new rules and regulations are leaving us overwhelmed. While we know this is difficult, we commend you for learning our new standards so your kids can keep doing what they love! We will consistently update our recital sites with any evolving and relevant information. Please be sure you are staying in the loop regarding important information. Our goal is the make the recital an organized, exciting experience for everyone involved. It's a team effort; students, their parents, the class instructors, and the studio director are key players in the show's success.

Your account must be current and outstanding balances paid before recital, or participation will be denied.

#### **BE PREPARED**

The recital is not a one-day activity. Gather all costume pieces, accessories, and shoes several days in advance so you'll know if something is missing.

### PART 2 - Costumes

#### COSTUME PICK-UP DAY

For the safety of our students and their families, JCDA will be hosting a separate costume pick-up day on <a href="Sunday April 18">Sunday April 18</a>. Dance families should report to the studio during the assigned time block (based on the child's last name), Parents will pull into one of our designated parking spots out front, and a staff member will meet you! We appreciate your patience and understanding throughout the pick-up process!

STUDENTS LAST NAME A-I Sunday April 18, 10am-12pm

STUDENTS LAST NAME J-Q Sunday April 18, 12pm-2pm

STUDENTS LAST NAME R-Z Sunday April 18, 2pm-4pm

#### **COSTUME DETAILS/ ALTERATIONS**

Once you receive your costume, please put your child's name on it immediately. Alternations may be necessary. We recommend trying on your child's costume again prior to picture day in case any alterations are needed.

Any alterations are the responsibility of the student, but we do have contact information for several seamstress' if any of our families are interested. Contact Miss Shari directly for information at 260-1787.

To ensure there are no problems, after initially trying on their costumes, students MUST not wear their costume prior to our picture day, dress rehearsal or the recital.

Do not wash costumes in your washing machine.

Included with your recital costume will be one pair of tights. All dancers need to wear tights with their costumes! Please remember that dancers do not wear underwear with their tights!

## PART 3 - The Performance Look

As we get closer to these recital events, we know our families will have lots of questions about the appropriate appearance of their dancers. We do have required hair and make-up that all students must follow, unless a teacher does request something different for a dance (i.e. bun, teased, hat, etc.) Those special requests can be found on the costume info sheet that is handed out with each of your child's costumes. Please use below as a reference when preparing your dancer's cosmetic bag for the big weekend!

#### HAIR

This year, we are going to require all dancers to wear their hair in a HIGH PONYTAIL. Please reference the pictures below for height.



- 1. Start by flipping hair over and gathering it high on the head. Brush out all of the bumps. Be sure to use water or styling spray to really comb out and up the baby hairs and "fringe" pieces.
- 2. Add hairspray or lacquer and comb through.
- 3. When smooth, secure elastic around pony (elastic should match hair tone). USE 2 ELASTICS and please be sure they are tight!
- 4. Spray hairspray or lacquer hair to slick back other pieces. Use soft brush to push back.
- 5. Dry the hairspray so it holds with hair spray.
- 6. Add finishing spray and bobby pins if needed for any fringe pieces.

\*\*Please go to <a href="https://www.YouTube.com">www.YouTube.com</a> to view "How to do a high neat ponytail for dance performances". Your pony doesn't need to be quite as high as illustrated in the video, but should be secured in the same way!

Remember, if a teacher asks for different hair for a certain dance, you child will follow those guidelines - especially those with hats or hair accessories!

Students with EXTREMELY short hair should talk to their teachers about an alternate hairstyle. Even girls with medium/short hair can get their hair up in a pony with some hair product!

#### MAKE-UP

We require our dancers to wear the following:

- Foundation/ Bronzer
- Dark Pink Blush
- White Eye shadow on entire eyelid
- Black Eye shadow inside the crease of eye
- Black eyeliner on the bottom and on the top along the lashes
- Black Mascara and/or False Eyelashes
- Bright Red Fire Engine Red Lipstick

It doesn't have to be name-brand or high-end make-up. Whatever your favorite brands are you can use, and drug store make-up can do wonders.

If you have any questions regarding this, feel free to ask a teacher or Miss Shari - she can help point you in the direction of the products she uses, and where to get them!

#### **JEWELRY**

A reminder that all students should have dance jewelry to wear at recital. This includes a rhinestone choker necklace and rhinestone earrings. Occasionally, a teacher will opt to use a costume piece rather than the necklace, however our jewelry never changes and dancers can use it in other classes and years to come! SAVE YOUR JEWELRY – save yourself \$25.00 next dance year!

New Students: Please notify Miss Shari IMMEDIATELY if you need jewelry. Call miss Shari at 260-1787 or make an appointment through our Calendly link. Be sure to let her know if your child will need clip-on earrings, and to make payment.

Returning Students: If you need replacement jewelry, add your name to the list and talk to Miss Shari ASAP. Earrings \$10, Choker \$15.

#### MASK RULE FOR PERFORMANCE

As our recital performance is OUTSIDE again this year, and social distancing will be adhered to during our performance, <u>masks for performers will be OPTIONAL</u> as it was last year. This is within our health and safety guidelines, but we will update you if this policy needs to be adapted. Performers as well as all participating individuals should wear mask where social distancing is not possible.

If dancers choose to wear a mask, we do ask that families purchase a flesh-toned mask. These masks can be purchased through Amazon, or Discount Dance Supply. If you need help locating a flesh-toned mask for your child, please contact us. We would be happy to help!

Dancers wearing flesh-toned masks will not be required to wear lipstick.

PLEASE NOTE: If performance is moved inside due to rain, we will require the use of masks for Performance at this time. We will have disposable flesh toned masks available onsite for our dancers if needed.

<u>Pictures will be taken in the studio at the times assigned in bold above.</u> A professional photographer from Images In Action will take individual pictures for those that are interested. There is no obligation to purchase pictures, and *dancers who are not interested in photos do not need to attend class the week of May 10^{th}-May 15th. The Google Classrooms will be updated for dancers who are not getting individual photos to practice their dance at home, along with additional warm-ups and fun dance activities.* 

Picture order forms are available in this packet on page 15 and must be filled out in advance. Dancers should arrive in their first costume with hair, make-up, tights and dance shoes as designated by your class instructor.

Photos will be available for pick-up during dress rehearsal week!

## PART 5 - Tickets

Included in the recital fee are 2 General Seating Tickets Per Student (as per the information on the Recital Form, all attendees must register submit their name, phone number and email for contract tracing purposes),

AS OF 5/15/21: FOR OUR PRE-COMP & TINY PRE-COMP SHOWCASE, EACH DANCE STUDENT WILL BE PERMITTED SEVEN (7) ADDITIONAL TICKETS FOR THEIR PERFORMANCE. THESE WILL BE AVAILABLE PRE-SALE ONLY. These tickets must be claimed IN-PERSON at the front desk by 5/27/20 - \$10.00 per ticket (cash and exact change only).

If the show is rained out and we are forced to use our indoor venue option (listed and explained below at the end of Part 9 - Showtime) masks will be required at all times. Thank you all for your continued understanding - we just can't wait to get our dancers back onstage!

We thank you for your patience and understanding as we navigate these ever-changing COVID guidelines and do our best to safely get our dancers back to stage.

Due to Contract Tracing purposes, we do need to currently keep a list of guests that plan to attend this year's show. Please provide the name, phone number, and email of the guests who will be using this year's parent tickets directly on the recital form. We will contact these people in the event of an emergency, a policy change for guests in accordance with NYS guidelines, or communication regarding inclement weather. Information will be destroyed after our show. Thank you so much for your cooperation in keeping our dance family safe during our 2021 show!

Please put your tickets in a safe place. Unfortunately, this year we are unable to look up tickets, and all people in attendance require a ticket.

We will be providing a livestream option for our recital again this year. The link will be sent via email to the family email we currently have on file for you. Feel free to share this link with family that cannot join us in person. Please Note: This is a complimentary service, and

our livestream operators will be running other elements of our show as well. We cannot always prevent any stream interruptions or connection errors, A full recording of the show will be emailed to our families for digital download in at the end of the summer and we also encourage you to share this link with loved ones as well!

## PART 6 - Order Your Video Recording Of The Show

This year, JCDA wanted to make our video experience some that all of our dancers could have, so we have built it in to the recital fee price! Included in your recital fee, you will recital a digital copy of our 2021 Shows filmed by a videographer from DMG Media Group will be videoing and professionally editing the recital in a simpler format, which will allow for much faster turn around times! With this link, you can download the show, burn your own DVD copies, send to families out-of-state, and watch at home to relive your recital experience! You don't need to do anything additional to receive your digital link – all of our students will be emailed an access link before the new dance year through the primary email the studio has on file!

DVD's can still be made by special request for \$25 per copy if you prefer that. To submit your DVD Form, please complete the form on page 13 and submit no later than the day of recital, Friday June  $4^{th}$ . PLEASE NOTE: These DVD's will be delivered to the studio in the Fall of the 2021 Dance year. Families with orders will be notified by e-mail that the DVD's are available for pick-up at the desk.

#### PARENT VOLUNTEERS

Our parent volunteers must arrive 30 minutes before your child's show for assignments and information. Volunteers must be responsible for keeping the class under control before and during the show, help organize bathroom runs, and be sure the dancers are accounted for,

enforcing social distancing, and stage-ready with the help of our staff! Parent Volunteers are permitted to a backstage viewing of your child's dance too!

This is a great way to free up an additional ticket for your family to see the show, as our Parent Volunteers are considered "staff" via the NYS guidelines, not one of the 2 spectators per dancer. (Please be sure to call from front desk at 260-1787 to update your spectator ticket contact information if you are choosing to volunteer. Thank you for your cooperation!)

## PART 8 - Dress Rehearsal

#### Tuesday June 1<sup>st</sup> @ Cardinal O'Hara HS Indoor Auditorium

Participation in the dress rehearsal is mandatory. The dress rehearsal allows the students to become familiar with the theatre surroundings and feel comfortable with their performance, costume(s), and being onstage.

We are THRILLED to announce that we will be using the INDOOR stage at Cardinal O'Hara fro Dress Rehearsal this year! Your dress rehearsal date is TUESDAY JUNE 1<sup>ST</sup>. The full schedule is posted below for your planning and convenience. We appreciate your understanding as we try to prepare our dancers for the big stage!

Arrive at least 20 minutes BEFORE your <u>dress rehearsal time</u>. We do our best to run on time, but please note that we sometimes run ahead and also sometimes behind schedule. Please be patient with all staff and students participating. We do our very best to run an organized dress rehearsal, and your help with the process will guarantee a professional production.

DROP OFF:

When dropping off your child, please park in the front of the building. NO ONE will be permitted to use the backstage doors for the Safety of our students. If you have a young child, please walk them in and check-in at the table. Check-in will be inside the lobby in front of the auditorium doors. ALL DANCERS MUST CHECK IN AT THE TABLE. Be sure your child is dressed in their first scheduled dance costume with tights, jewelry, hair and make-up, and dance shoes that are labeled with their name (because it is inside, our dancers should wear masks, however for the outdoor show it is not required – so don't forget the lipstick;). In the event of rain, dancers will need to wear a mask for their performance, but we are hopeful this won't be an issue!).

A dressing room will be provided for our dancers during dress rehearsal, however parents should keep costume pieces with them in the auditorium, Thank you for your cooperation. Dancers will sit in the middle section with the row assigned for their class.

PLEASE NOTE: THIS IS NOT OUR PLANNED PERFORMANCE VENUE. We still intend to be OUTSIDE at Cardinal O'Hara HS, and several of our parent volunteers and assistants will be on hand to provide tours to our parents of the outdoor performance area during dress rehearsal so there are no surprises the day of show! The indoor stage will be our "Rain Performance" in the event of in-climate weather ONLY - masks MUST be worn in this event. Thank you for your patience and understanding.

PICK-UP:

before you leave the building, BE SURE YOU HAVE ALL OF YOUR CHILD'S COSTUME AND PERFORMANCE ITEMS! Also, please check with your dance instructor for permission to leave rehearsal. Be sure you stop by the tee-shirt table to get your child's dance tee-shirt and the picture pick-up booth to pick up any dance photos before you leave; these booths with NOT be set up at recital!

## PART 9 - Showtime!

Friday, June 4th 2021 7:00pm, "Doors" at 6:30pm @ Cardinal O'Hara Sports Complex 39 O'Hara Rd Tonawanda NY 14150

As the recital approaches we want to take a moment to review our updated outdoor procedures and policies so that everything runs as smoothly as possible.

- Dancers should arrive no later than 20 minutes before their show. A show order is listed below for your convenience.
- 2. Once you pull in the parking lot, you will enter through door number 1, which is the main entrance (this is referenced in our walk through video as well, please see that on this page as well as posted here: <a href="https://youtu.be/hNQiOTLhu4w">https://youtu.be/hNQiOTLhu4w</a>). Continue straight and exit out the double doors. Here you will see the dance check-in station, and you will stop to check in your dancer for their show. Tiny Pre-Comp Parents are welcome to hold your child's additional costume(s), and take their recital tee-shirt (we don't want any getting lost backstage!). A JCDA Staff member will safely escort dancers back to their classes meeting place backstage. Parents don't forget everything you need for an outdoor show: your folding chairs, sunscreen, bug spray, and masks! Masks must be worn when social distancing is not possible (for example; should you choose to sit under the audience tent).
  - a. During the age of COVID-19, please be sure the current cell-phone number we have on file for you is correct for use during the show. If your child needs to use the bathroom, or if we need you for something, we will have our staff send a quick text message, and we can meet you at the check-in table and get you to your child quickly. We do recommend that children use the bathroom before they leave home, or once you arrive before check-in!
  - b. We also recommend parents hold on to the recital tee-shirts once received, until after the performance, so they do not become lost or mixed up with another student's shirt in the backstage area.

- c. If you have someone in your party who needs assistance in being transported to the audience area, please notify us IN ADVANCE. We can make accommodations for easy accessibility if we are notified by Thursday, June  $4^{\rm th}$ .
- 3. ONLY studio staff and dance recital participants will be allowed in the dressing room located inside the Cardinal O'Hara gymnasium, boys dressing room, and the backstage areas. Children in each class will be assigned a parent volunteer, JCDA alumni, teacher, and student teachers. Pre-Comp students with changes should set their belongings up in their own space in the gymnasium. Several racks will be provided for costumes, for your convenience, but we recommend that you CLEARLY MARK each hanger with your child's name. Please remind your child to put all costumes, shoes, and accessories into their bag as soon as they are finished with them. If your child has many costumes, we recommend creating a "cheat sheet", like the slip we attached to each costume. This helps the dancers with a checklist of what they should be wearing before they take the stage!
  - a. Tiny Pre-Comp Parents: upon receipt of this packet information, a backstage pass was issued to allow you to go backstage to help your dancer change if they are in multiple dances. Once they have changed and you have collected their other costume, we ask that you safely return to the audience area to watch your child's next dance.
- 4. While dancers are waiting back stage for their opportunity to dance we will use safety spots from the studio to be sure students are maintaining social distancing, and adults will monitor this in the dressing rooms. For our tot dancers, we will have safety ropes marked where dancers can hold on as they enter and exit the stage if need be. Masks are not required backstage, but because dancers may pass each other a bit more closely inside the dressing room, it is encouraged.
  - a. Dancers may bring water to drink. WATER is the only acceptable beverage to have backstage. Please try to send in a water bottle with a sports cap so that spills are minimal, and please be sure it is clearly labeled with your child's name. Be sure not to leave it behind!
  - b. Dancers MAY NOT bring any electronic devices in the dressing room tent or backstage. We will not be responsible for any missing devices.
- 5. Dancers will perform their dances, and once they are finished with their last dance, they will be released back to their families to either depart, or to watch the remainder of the show. Anything left behind is collected and available for pick-up during the office hours we provide after the show. Any items remaining after the season will be donated.

#### a. Release Methods

- i. **Pre-Comp Dancers** will return to the dressing room to collect their belongings, and parents can line up along the left of the stage to pick them up there and return back to your seats.
- ii. **Tiny Pre-Comp Dancers** will be released DIRECTLY FROM STAGE after their last dance of the day. Of course, we do encourage you to stay through the end of your assigned show to celebrate the work of all of these dancers!
- b. Masks MAY be worn by performers, at the discretion of each dancer/family. We have recommended to several dancers who have asked to look on Amazon or to find someone local who makes masks to possibly find one that is flesh colored. These are not required while our kids are dancing, but are welcomed. If you would prefer your child wear a single use surgical mask or a higher grade medical mask, we also understand that as well. Please feel free to discuss this with your child's teacher, Miss Jackie or Miss Shari if you have any concerns or questions regarding this. You can reach us by phone (717-260-1787) or email (<a href="JCDAdance@gmail.com">JCDAdance@gmail.com</a>). We want our kids and parents to have a safe and wonderful experience.
- c. Please, refrain from leaving in the middle of a dance. Getting up during our show is distracting to other patrons and may block them from their opportunity to see their child. We ask that you be courteous there will be a small break between each classes dance, and if you must vacate during the show, we ask you to wait

until the appropriate time to do so. Our shorter show should run approximately 45 minutes - making for a hopefully relaxing evening of dance!

- 6. Concessions will be available for purchase outside at our event as well! Concessions include Gatorade, Water, Pop, Chips, and Candy for purchase. *Please, cash only*.
- 7. Bathrooms are located inside the building behind our concessions, where our families entered the building. The men's bathroom is on left side and the women's is around the corner just to the left. These indoor bathrooms will be sanitized regularly throughout the day by the Cardinal O'Hara staff. Please wear your mask when you are inside the school for any reason at all.
- 8. Don't forget to pick up those dance photos from picture day during recital week! We will have unclaimed picture packages on the premises, and we want to be sure you don't leave without them!
- 9. We will have a JCDA INFO TABLE with a JCDA Staff member or volunteer for you to turn in your Recital DVD Form (a digital recording is already included in your recital package and will be sent automatically during the summer months, but if you'd like a physical DVD this is for you!), or to turn in your Fall Registration Form. Please let us know if you have any questions, and if our JCDA Representative can't answer it for you right there, they will write it down, and we will get back to you the week of June 7-11 via phone or email!
- 10. JCDA Staff will be set up for you to grab your Pre-Sale Flowers (Pre-Sale ONLY), Jewelry and JCDA Unicorns and Koalas as well! If we have any stuffed animals or jewelry left after all Pre-Sale orders have been accounted for, we will bring them for families that may like to purchase the day of. *Cash Only, please!*

If you have any questions, please seek out a staff member at any time. Together, with a little patience and understanding, we are confident we can make this a wonderful recital weekend. Thank you for helping us to make the show a success!

## PART 10 - Social Distancing & Safety Guidelines

In this uncertain time, JCDA and Cardinal O'Hara High School is committed to providing a safe experience for all of our families coming to our show, and remaining well within the NYS guidelines for the show. This is what we are doing to keep the dancers and attendees safe:

- 1. On your Recital Form, you should have filled in Spectator Contact Information. As per an agreement with our host venue, please provide the names and contact information of the SPECTATORS attending the event with your dancer. Please Note: Your information is being collected for potential contract tracing purposes and emergency contacts regarding shows or rain dates. Your information will not be shared with any additional parties, or used for any additional purposes. This will be destroyed and files deleted 2-weeks after our event. Thank you for your cooperation!
  - Cardinal O'Hara is asking guest to adhere by NYS guidelines for face coverings. When seated outdoors comfortable in pods outdoors, masks may be removed as long as social distancing remains possible. Thank you for your cooperation with this.
- 3. JCDA will provide several sanitation stations that include hand sanitizer. Bathrooms are steps away, and will be sanitized often by the Cardinal O'Hara staff.
  - 4. Our smaller shows allow for less dancers in our backstage area, less spectators, and allow us to sanitize the stage after between sub-shows to be sure our dancers are staying SAFE.

- 5. Please, throw out your trash and collect all of your belongings before leaving the premises'. This will help us keep our employees and the employees from Cardinal O'Hara safe.
- 6. Remember to bring those positive vibes with you! We ask all of our families to be PATIENT with our staff as we are navigating another outdoor show at a new place. We are working on signage, stations, and checkpoints to be sure we have everything laid out as clearly as possible for you and your family. Also, remember to love one another. We have the BEST dance parents, and we are looking so forward to watching you all enjoy this unique experience together!

#### IN THE EVENT OF RAIN:

We have been working with the venue to utilize the indoor auditorium stage if needed. Our shows would occur at the same times, just indoors rather than outside. Masks and social distancing would be required.

We will keep all of our dance families informed on very specific details on the day of show via e-mail and possibly text message should we need to use these options.

We ask all of our families to pray for sunshine, and great weather for our beautiful dancers to enjoy their weekend!
